

An Introduction to Webpage Design

This 10 session course offers you a chance to get hands-on experience of building not one but two websites. One built using hypertext markup language (HTML) and one using a 'what you see is what you get' (wysiwyg) editor program that saves you writing the tags...



The course will also look at important essentials like how to get your website up and running online – e.g. getting your own domain name, getting a hosting package and using FTP (file transfer protocol) – along with concerns about online payments and security.

The intention of the course is to give you an excellent grounding in knowing the basics of developing a

website and to help you take charge of its development and direction – without it costing the Earth. You'll find the nuts & bolts skills you learn here will come in handy whether you intend to become a web designer by trade, or want to build a website to suit your own interest or business purposes.
